STATEWIDE WORKSHOPS

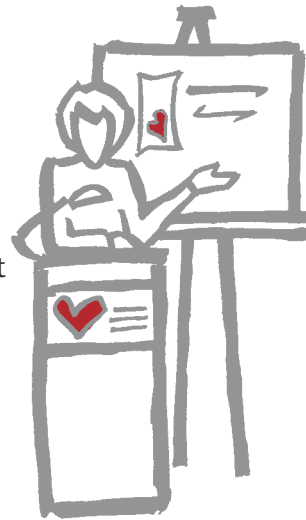
Meetings are held each year throughout the state on subjects of particular and immediate interest to you and your staff.
