What is a Community Outing?



A Community Outing

A prepared opportunity to participate in recreation in the community in a successful and adapted way to have enjoyment and engagement

Considerations for Community Outings



- Identify appropriate participants who can safely enjoy the outing with approval from nursing and administrator
- Call ahead to be sure they can accommodate your special population
- Understand all of the steps needed for success and preparation
- Establish outings around interests and hobbies of the residents
- Be sure you have adequate family and volunteers to participate with staff for good support ratios

Care Considerations




- Review residents who can safely participate
- May need doctor's orders
- May need family permission
- Make sure residents have had opportunity to use the restroom before leaving
- Make sure residents are dressed for the weather and occasion with proper footware
- Bring information sheets of residents with emergency contact, allergies and DNR
- Bring supply bag with wipes, gloves, continence products and first aid kit

Planning Considerations




- Call ahead to be sure they can accommodate your resident needs and wheelchair accommodations
- Confirm where the residents can be let off
- Confirm where the transportation can park
- Determine funding/ money needs for the group if cash or credit card
- Explain the group has dementia and adaptions to consider to make the outing successful
- Have a flyer and sign up sheet for families to sign up to join you

Ideas for Outings



- Themed scenic ride for the season
- •50's music, rootbeer floats, and drive through the neighborhoods
- Lemonade, summer songs and go feed/ observe the ducks
- Apple cider, big band music and fall foliage tour
- Cocoa and caroling and Christmas lights tour
- Coffee, marching band music and watch a football team practice
- Country tunes, milkshakes and see local landmarks

More Ideas for Outings



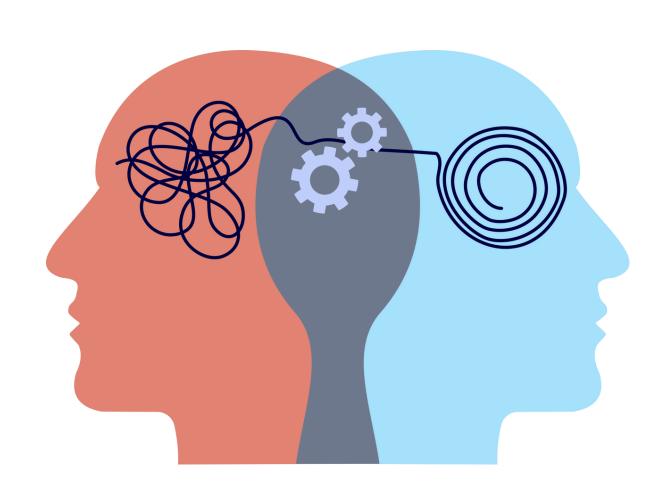
- With the right planning and preparation many things are possible

- Be sure that residents participating have been approved by nursing
- Have supplies needed
- Call ahead for preparation of accommodations and understanding population's needs
- Adequate support ratios for participants
- Bring medical information sheets
- Review company policies on outings and follow accordingly
- Take pictures
- Have fun
